Mr. Pickard was a photographer until he lost his eyesight. The family lived on a farm outside of Zavalla in the Bugscuffle School area.

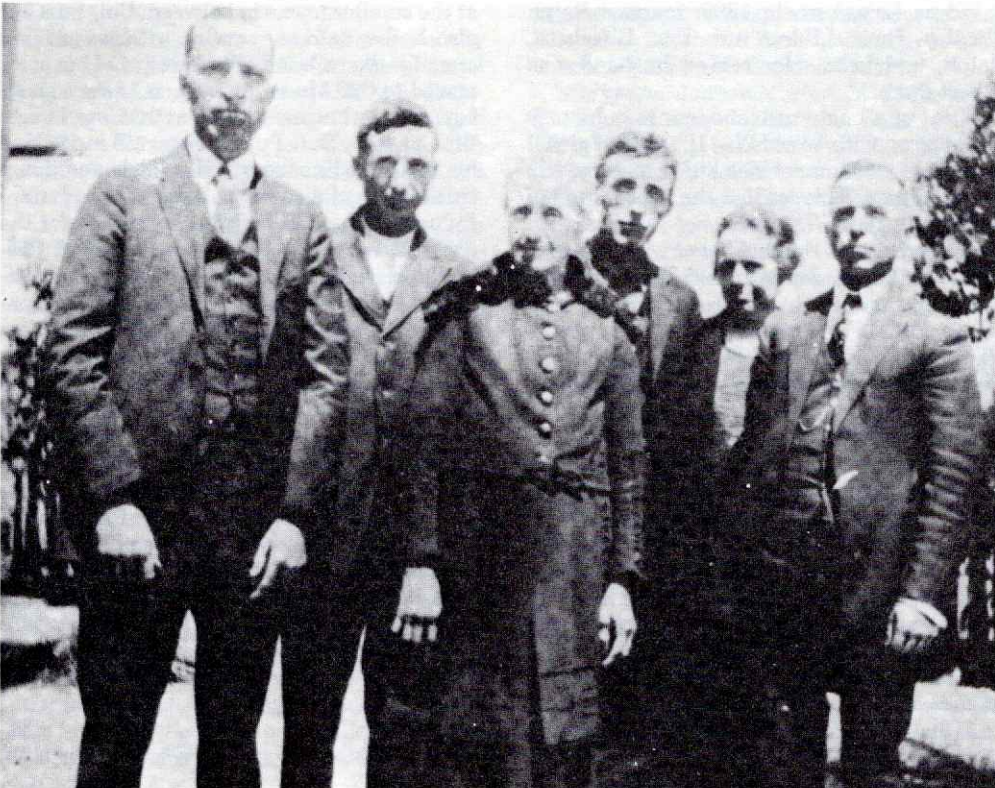
Joe Logan Pickard passed away March 29, 1918 and Priscilla F. Pickard passed away April 28, 1954. Both are buried at the Cochran Cemetery in the Ora Community.

Jerome B. Pickard was born December 7, 1883 and married Laura Dearmond on December 26, 1904. Laura passed away November 24, 1917 and was buried at the Cochran Cemetery. Jerome B. Pickard married Millie Roberts on July 4, 1918. Millie passed away May 22, 1990 and Jerome passed away April 30, 1969; both being buried in the Zavalla Cemetery.

Willie M. Pickard was born July 15, 1886, and on August 2, 1908, married Nina Herring of San Augustine County. Willie M. Pickard passed away on November 16, 1964, and Nina Pickard passed away on July 16, 1978. Both are buried at Levelland, Texas.

Co-Della Pickard was born December 16, 1888 and on the 20th day of October, 1915, was married to Ordie Cleveland Stuart. Mr. Stuart passed away February 19, 1964, and Della Stuart passed away September 27, 1976. Both are buried at the Cochran Cemetery in the Ora Community.

# PINNER, ANN D. (ANDY) AND MARTHA ANN ALLEN

Ann D. (Andy) Pinner came to Angelina County in the early 1890's, about 1892. He was born in McLennan County, Texas, November 17, 1876. Living in the Allentown area, he married Martha Ann Allen, oldest child and daughter of Hiram Andrew (Bud) and Mary Ann Allen. They were married on September 11, 1897 and were given some acreage by Mr. Allen. Martha Ann was born in Allentown on June 14, 1877. They cleared and farmed their land, and had seven children; a baby born and died in September 1898; Joe Gordon, Verna Mae, Samuel I.D., Willie Franklin (Bill), and Ruby Watts.

Gordon born September 20, 1899 married Mina Estelle Pate on November 18, 1922, and died October 11, 1942. Verna Mae, born February 28, 1901, married Clint Brookshire, February 20, 1928, and died August 19, 1988. Samuel, born July 26, 1903, married Mary Elv Allen on July 3, 1925, and died May 30, 1968. I.D., born February 27, 1905 and died April 21, 1907. Willie Franklin (Bill), born April 16, 1908, married Alice Allen on March 19, 1933. Ruby Watts (Tobe) born June 4, 1910, married Hazel Dunn on October 8, 1938, and they still live at Pollok.

Andy, having had cancer for many years, was moved from the old homestead near where Ezra and Mattie Allen lived, to the site of the present Allentown Pentacoastal Church in Allentown. He died there on January 5, 1938. Martha Ann Pinner died in Moffett on September 25, 1959. Many of their grandchildren and families still live in the Allentown area, and in Dallas, Houston, Beaumont, Corpus Christi, Sequin, and Arlington.

Andy and Martha Ann Pinner are buried at the Gann Cemetery.
